Dear Division of Local Government:

Please find attached the 2015 budget for the Mesa County Federal Mineral Lease District.

Following the passage of the Federal Mineral Lease District Act (the "Act") (Colorado House Bill 11-1218) and the addition to Colorado Statutes of C.R.S. § 30-20-1301 *et seq*, the Mesa County Federal Mineral Lease (FML) District was created by resolution on June 20, 2011. In 2012, Colorado's legislation was substantially amended to address several issues identified by the Department of the Interior. Following this new legislation, the Mesa County FML District was modified to recognize the redrafted statutes. The District is an independent public body politic and corporate, with a perpetual existence.

The District Board distributes the funding that the District receives from DOLA, except such funds as expended or reserved for administrative expenses as permitted by C.R.S. § 30-20-1307 (1) (b), to areas that are socially or economically impacted by the development, processing, or energy conversion of fuels and minerals leased under the Federal "Mineral Lands Leasing Act" of February 1920, as amended.

In 2014, the District received \$1,753,780.05 and in 2013 \$1,023,424.37. The District has invited grant applications for the fall 2015 cycle and plans to distribute the funds through the current and future grant cycles.

The Federal Mineral Lease District will follow the cash budgetary basis of accounting.
